Medicaid's Goals

- 1. Early Intervention and Prevention
- 2. Improved Behavioral Health
- 3. Improved Maternal Health outcomes
- 4. Improving health and increasing savings through value- and outcome-based payments.



January 1, 2024*

PCMH Addendum:

- 1. Added metrics for colorectal cancer screenings & well-child visits.
- 2. Added information metrics for HPV vaccine & developmental screens.
- 3. Created an add-on for practices that have trained and are implementing the Healthy Steps evidence-based model for beneficiaries aged 0-48 months.
 - 1. The add-on PMPM is \$3.44
 - 2. Must implement to fidelity
- Developmental Screening by PCPs:
 - 1. For ages 0-48 months, PCP will be able to bill for one (1) screen per year.
 - 2. \$8.80 per screen.
- ❖ Act 581-Hospital Reimbursement of LARCS:
 - 1. Coverage during a hospital stay for delivery.
- Counseling Rates:
 - 1. Making the individual counseling rate increase permanent (to 80% of Medicare)
 - 2. Decreasing the group counseling rates to 100% of Medicare
 - 3. Adding maternal depression screens for PCPs (including pediatricians)

*All dates are anticipated effective dates and subject to Legislative and CMS approval.



February 1, 2024

- ❖ Act 480-Coordinated Triage, Treat, and Transport benefit (ET3):
 - 1. Mirrors Medicare program.
 - 2. Allows Ambulance Providers to treat in place or transport to an alternate destination, *IF* a consult with a physician or licensed BH clinician occurs.
 - Alternate Destinations include: FQHC, Physician's Office, CSU, Urgent Care, or behavioral health care facility.
 - 3. Will pay at ALS or BLS rates.
- Adult Immunization Coverage:
 - 1. CMS Mandated that we cover all ACIP recommended vaccinations for adults.
 - 2. This will add dengue, varicella, Japanese encephalitis, and HPV
 - 3. Required for DOS from 10/1/23 on.
- Act 59-Rural Emergency Hospitals (will likely be extended):
 - 1. Mirrors CMS rule for Medicare designation.
 - 2. Allows Critical Access Hospitals (CAH) to become REHs.
 - 3. Will pay as CAHs.
 - 4. On hold with CMS as they navigate the new rule's application to Medicaid.



April 1, 2024

- ❖ Act 393-Continuous Glucose Monitoring (CGM)—delayed.
 - 1. Allow CGMs to be delivered at a pharmacy.
 - 2. Collect rebate.
 - 3. Still negotiating with CMS on how best to implement.
- CMS Mandated vaccine counseling for EPSDT.
 - 1. Still finalizing policy.
 - 2. Will cover for all vaccines for children under EPSDT.



July 1, 2024

- Acts 303/872-Clinical Nurse Specialists and Physician Assistants as rendering and billing providers:
 - 1. Will have to enroll and receive a provider number.
 - 2. Will receive 80% of physician rate.



Other Initiatives

- Electronic Visit Verification for Home Health:
 - 1. Will be sending communication on enrolling direct care workers as rendering providers.
 - 2. Will send communication on training with the EVV system for those providers.
 - 3. No hard cut off will be implemented until all of that has occurred.
- Maternal Life360:
 - 1. Working on entering start up agreements with first group of providers.
- ❖ TEFRA Renewal:
 - 1. Still pending with CMS.
 - 2. Will streamline re-enrollment for categorical diagnoses.
- Hepatitis C Drugs:
 - 1. Removed Fibrosis Score as criteria for prior authorization.
